Educational objective

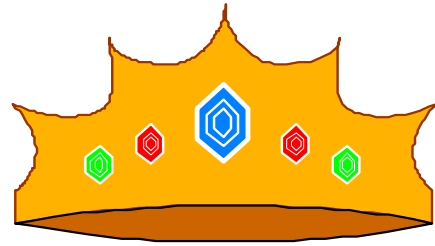
A challenge for younger children to design and make familiar objects.
